


#### Mobile Website

One of the frustrations with mobile versions of websites is that they are limited or do not work as well. The new mobile District website has ALL the same features as the full website.

Just go to the same <a href="http://www.ghcsd.org">http://www.ghcsd.org</a> site and it will automatically figure out if you need the mobile site. The main page will show events and news, but once you click the <a href="mailto:lick.org">low button at the top, you will see all the different menus.</a>







#### Interactive Event Calendar


To view the event calendar, you can either click "all events" at the bottom left of the main page, or click "Calendars" at the top menu.

Here you can flip through each month, look at specific buildings or activities, print out a printer-friendly copy, or subscribe to the calendar with Google Calendar, iCal, etc.
